A RORC working party* have undertaken a review of the Offshore Special Regulations.

Light characteristics are covered on paper navigational charts and electronic navigational charts. Commercial vessels operate AIS and it is a requirement (OSR 3.29.13) for vessels in MoMu0,1,2,3 to have AIS where full details of any vessels are viewable.
