

World Sailing Class World Championship Report

Introduction

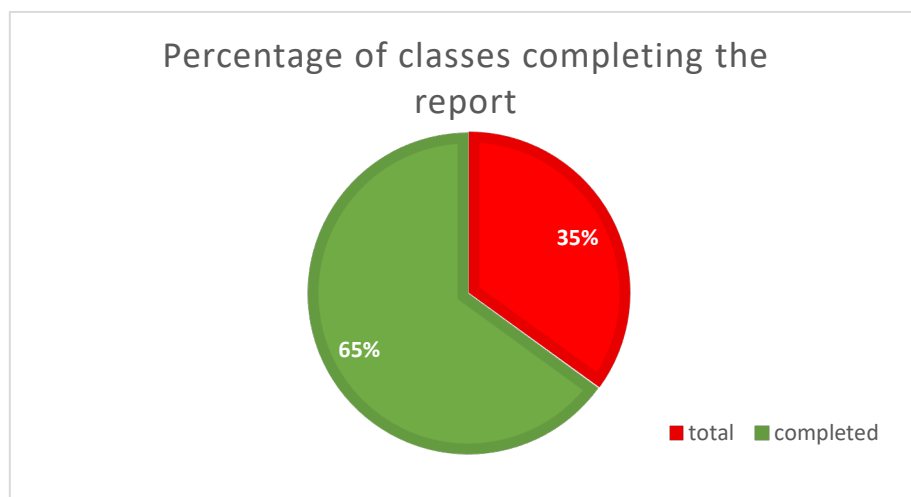
World Sailing (WS) Regulations 10.4 stipulate that WS classes are required to submit a report on the class world championship(s) to the Executive Office. This report should be provided as soon as possible after the championship but no later than the 1 February annual report, including all necessary information outlined by WS. Failure to submit this report may lead to a review of the Class's right to hold a world championship, irrespective of other Regulations.

In previous years, this report was incorporated into the annual report submitted by the classes no later than February. To assist classes in adhering to this regulation, our office has introduced a specific form to be completed following each championship. The information required includes:

- Class Association
- Event name
- Date and place
- Championship results
- Number of entries, countries, and continents (Regulation 10.4e)
- International Jury members (Regulation 10.4c)
- International Technical Committee (Regulation 10.4d)
- Venue feedback
- Reporting system feedback

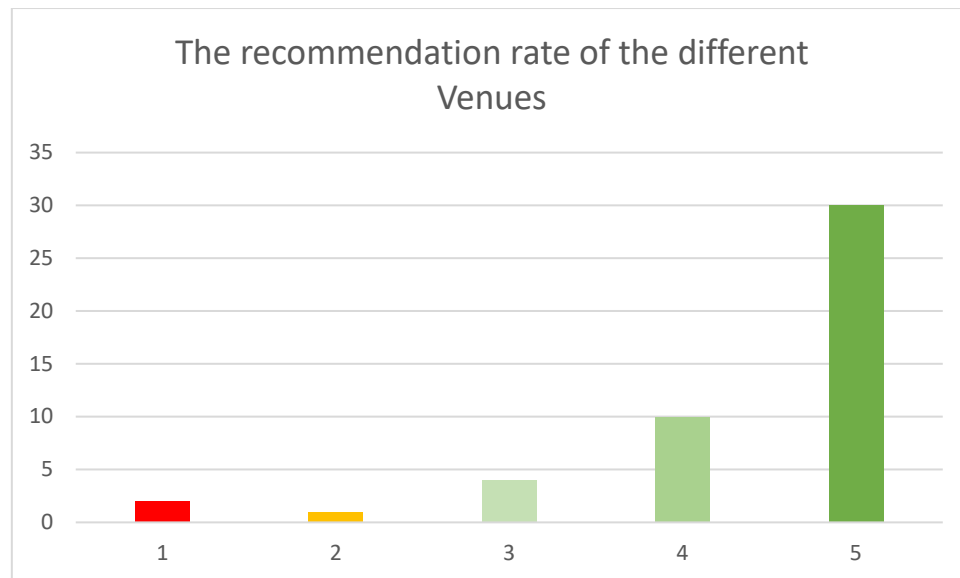
Results

The implementation of this form commenced in January 2023. In the period from January to the end of September, a total of 77 classes conducted their World Championships. Impressively, 50 of these classes completed and submitted the required report, representing an outstanding compliance rate of 65%.

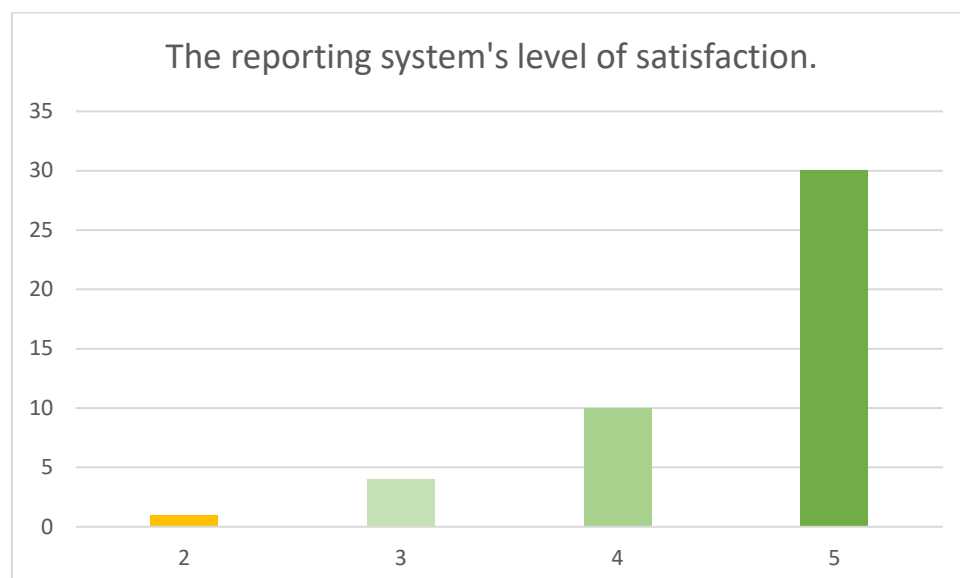


Furthermore, it is worth noting that an overwhelming 96% of the classes that submitted the report had indeed hosted a valid championship, underscoring the reliability of the reported data.

Additionally, from the 50 classes that completed the report, a substantial 98% of them highly recommended the venues where their Championships took place. This indicates both the venues' quality and the classes' satisfaction in this regard.



Regarding the reporting system itself, an impressive 98% of the classes rated it on a scale from 1 to 5, with an average rating exceeding 3. This strongly reflects the user-friendliness and effectiveness of the system.



This report demonstrates the positive progress made in meeting WS Regulations 10.4, improving the transparency and quality of information, and enhancing the overall experience of our class championships. We applaud the dedication of the classes in fulfilling their responsibilities and the improvements made in reporting these crucial events to WS.
