

Racing Rules of Sailing

C6.1 and C6.2

A submission from the Chair of the Racing Rules Committee

Purpose or Objective

Make the rule clearer to understand.

Proposal

Change rule C6.1 and C6.2 to:

C6.1 A boat may protest another boat

- (a) under a rule of Part 2, except rule 14, by clearly displaying flag Y immediately after an incident in which she was involved;
- (b) under any rule not ~~listed~~ **protestable** in rule C6.1(a) or C6.2 by clearly displaying a red flag as soon as possible after the incident.

C6.2 A boat may not protest another boat under

- (a) rule 14, ~~unless~~ **if no** damage or injury results;
- (b) a rule of Part 2, unless she was involved in the incident;
- (c) rule 31 or 42; or
- (d) rule C4 or C7.

Current Position

1. The Match racing Rules Working Party have considered this issue and propose this submission.
 2. Assists sailors understanding of what can be protested and how this is protested.
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
