Rule F5 64

A submission from the International Formula Kite Class Association

Purpose or Objective

Extend the count of tangles in an event to all hearings.

Proposal

64 DECISIONS

~~Add new rule 64.2(c):~~

~~(c) if a kiteboard has broken a rule and, as a result, caused a tangle for the second or subsequent time during the event, her penalty shall be a disqualification that is not excludable.~~

Add new rule 64.7:

64.7 When the protest committee decides that a boat that is a party to a hearing has broken a rule and is not exonerated and, as a result, caused a tangle for the second or subsequent time during the event, her penalty shall be a disqualification that is not excludable.

Current Position

As above.

Reasons

The intention of the rule is that any tangle caused by a kiteboard, counts towards the total number of tangles caused during an event. Rule 64.2 refers to protest hearings but not redress hearings. Moving the rule to a separate article within rule 64 fixes this.

Note: If this change is approved, rule 64.7 shall be added to the rules listed in 63.1
