Regulation 10.2.1: Status of World Sailing Classes for Olympic Equipment

Regulation 10.4: right to hold a World Championship

A submission from the Equipment Committee Chair

Purpose or Objective

To prevent issues when Olympic Equipment is selected, but the class is not recognized as a World Sailing Class Association, and to provide added value to the Olympic classes' world championship.

Proposal

To add to regulation 10.2.1:

10.2.1(k): classes selected as current Olympic equipment are automatically granted designation as a World Sailing Class Association.

To add to regulation 10.4:

10.4(g) classes selected as current Olympic equipment are automatically granted the right to host a World championship and such a championship may be named “name of the class elite world championship”.

Current Position

Some Olympic equipment classes may not be members of World Sailing, which can lead to administration issues if they do not meet the minimum requirements set by the organization.

Reasons

1. This proposal aims to resolve the problem of Olympic classes that don't meet the minimum requirement to be a World Sailing class. It seeks to eliminate any issues related to this matter.
 2. Many Class Associations host world championships. The designation as “elite” would indicate that classes selected as Olympic Equipment have an enhanced status.
