Amendment One

Original Wording:

- 43.3 The measurement certificate ceases to be valid:
- (a) **two** years after the date of issuance;
 - (b) if there is any change in the yacht's displacement or trim, including alterations in the internal ballast;
 - (c) if there is any change made to the hull or its appendages that may alter any of the measurements on the measurement certificate;
 - (d) if any dimension of the rated sail area is increased;
 - (e) if the position of the forestay is moved;
 - (f) the position of the mast at any time reduces the J measurement by more than 200mm, or the pivot point of the mast is moved by more than by 75mm;

Proposed New Wording :

- 43.3 The measurement certificate ceases to be valid:
- (a) **four** years after the date of issuance;
 - (b) if there is any change in the yacht's displacement or trim, including alterations in the internal ballast;
 - (c) if there is any change made to the hull or its appendages that may alter any of the measurements on the measurement certificate;
 - (d) if any dimension of the rated sail area is increased;
 - (e) if the position of the forestay is moved;
 - (f) the position of the mast at any time reduces the J measurement

Reasons:

At the Class Annual General Meeting on October 28, 2023 the Class Membership unanimously decided to change the Measurement Certificate validity period to 4 years from 2 years to the reduce the ongoing inconvenience and cost of Rule compliance.
