

WORLD SAILING POLICY REGISTER

OLYMPIC RACE OFFICIALS

1. Appointment of Olympic Race Officials

- 1.1 If there is a conflict between this policy and Policy L1, this Policy takes precedence.
- 1.2 The Board appoints:
 - (a) the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Olympic Jury;
 - (b) the Principal Race Officer and Deputy Principal Race Officer;
 - (c) the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Olympic Technical Committee; and
 - (d) the Chief Umpire and Deputy Chief Umpire.
- 1.3 The Board appoints also the other members of the Olympic Jury as follows:
 - (a) All members of the Olympic Jury must be International Judges.
 - (b) No more than two members of the Olympic Jury can be from the same Member National Authority.
 - (c) There must be one member of the Olympic from each of:
 - (i) the Member National Authority of the nation which is hosting the Olympic Sailing Competition; and
 - (ii) the Member National Authority of the nation which is hosting the next Olympic Sailing Competition.
- 1.4 Before the Board makes any appointments, it must:
 - (a) consider recommendations from:
 - (i) the Event Appointments Working Group;
 - (ii) the Chair of the Race Officials Committee;
 - (iii) the Chair of the Racing Rules Committee; and
 - (b) for appointments to the Olympic Jury, consult the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Olympic Jury.
- 1.5 No person who has a conflict of interest may make a recommendation or be consulted. However, once the conflict no longer exists, the person may then be involved.
