SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 National prescriptions will apply: *All competitors are required to wear personal flotation devices at all times whilst afloat.*
- 1.3 For all races, World Sailing Appendix UF, Umpired Fleet Racing, will apply and takes precedence over any conflicting instructions.

2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be informed verbally on the water.

3 ENTRIES

- 3.1 This race is open to 5 teams for participation. Each team comprises of 1 skipper and 4 team members.

4 BOATS

- 4.1 Boats will be provided for all competitors, who shall not modify them or cause them to be modified in any way.
- 4.2 All equipment provided with the boat for sailing purposes shall be in the boat while afloat.
- 4.3 The penalty for not complying with any of the above instructions will be at the discretion of the protest committee.
- 4.4 Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the organizing authority's representative immediately after securing the boat. The penalty for breaking this instruction, unless the protest committee is satisfied that the competitor made a determined effort to comply, will be disqualification from the race most recently sailed.
- 4.5 Competitors shall remove completely all markings or tape or instruments made by the competitors at the end of the regatta.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at SSF's pontoon at Marina Bay.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 10 minutes' in the race signal AP.



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6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

3 races are scheduled. No warning signal shall be made after 1800hrs.



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7 RACING AREAS

7.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 The diagram in Attachment 2 shows the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

9 MARKS

9.1 Mark 1 will be a green cylindrical mark and Mark 2 will be a red cylindrical mark. Mark 3 will be a yellow pyramid mark.

10 AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

10.1 The following areas are designated as obstructions:
Aerators pumps and marks, strobe, buoys that are part of the Marina Bay maintenance.

11 THE START AND FINISH

11.1 Races will be started as follows:

3 minutes – Red flag up with one sound signal

1 minutes – Red flag down, yellow flag up with one sound signal

0 minute (Start) – Yellow flag down, green/white flag up

11.2 The starting and finishing line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat at the starboard end and a red oval buoy.

12 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

The time limits and target times are as follows:

Time Limit	Mark 1 Time Limit	Finish Window	Target Time

12.1 If no boat has passed Mark 1 within the Mark 1 time limit the race will be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.1(a).

12.2 Boats failing to finish within 10 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

13 SCORING

13.1 The Low Point scoring system will apply, as per Rule A4. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.



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- 13.2 If there is a series-score tie between two or more boats, each boat's race scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat(s) with the best score(s). No excluded scores shall be used

14 REPLACEMENT OF CREW OR EQUIPMENT

- 14.1 Each team shall sail with at least 5 crew members.

15 EVENT ADVERTISING

- 15.1 Boats shall display event advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

16 OFFICIAL BOATS

- 16.1 Official boats will be marked as follows: Umpire – White flag with letter "U"

17 TRASH DISPOSAL

- 17.1 Trash shall be disposed when teams arrive back to the SSF's Pontoon.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 18.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

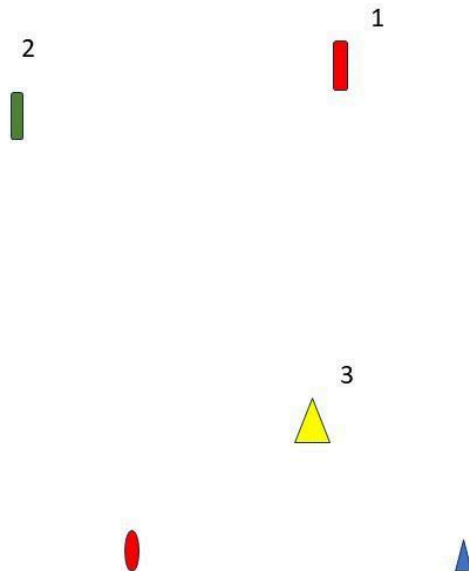
Diagram A – Racing Area
