Purpose or Objective

Housekeeping of the terminology in rule N1.1

Proposal

N1.1 An international jury shall be composed of experienced sailors with excellent knowledge of the ~~rac~~ing-rules and extensive protest committee experience. It shall be independent of and have no members from the race committee or the technical committee, and it shall be appointed by the organizing authority, subject to approval by the national authority if required (see rule 91(b)), or by World Sailing under rule 89.2(c).

Current Position:

Reason

In accordance with the 'Terminology' in the Introduction of the RRS, the term 'racing rules' specifically refers to *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. However, members of an international jury under Appendix N should have excellent knowledge of all *rules* as defined in Definition *Rule* and not just the 'racing rules'.
