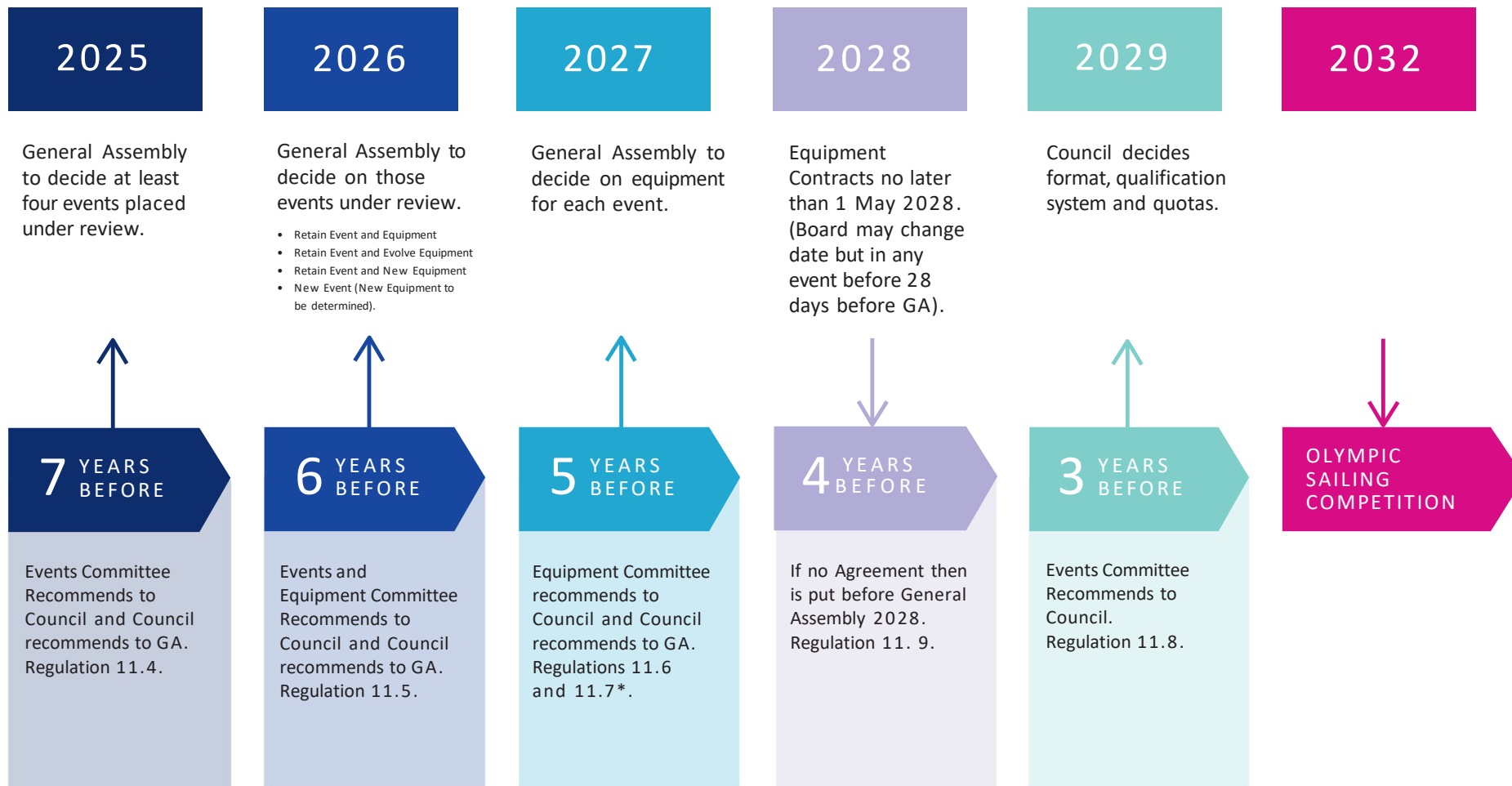


## Regulation 11 Timeline



GA can accept or reject Council recommendation and Council can accept or reject Events Committee/ Equipment Committee recommendation, but neither GA or Council can substitute their own decision.

\*Under Regulation 11.7 Equipment selected for each Olympic Event must be re-evaluated at least every eight years.

## Regulation 11 Timeline

2025

General Assembly

### Events Committee:

11.4(a) The GA must decide to place at least 4 Events under review.

11.4(b) Events not under review must be submitted to the IOC for approval when requested by it.

11.4(d) The decision is on the recommendation of the Events Committee.



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## Regulation 11 Timeline

2026

General Assembly to  
decide on those  
events under review.

- Retain Event and Equipment
- Retain Event and Evolve Equipment
- Retain Event and New Equipment
- New Event (New Equipment to be determined).

Regulation 11.5.

### Events and Equipment Committee:

11.5(a) The GA must decide whether to:

- (i) retain the Event and retain the current Equipment;
- (ii) retain the Event but evolve the current Equipment;
- (iii) retain the Event but select new Equipment; or
- (iv) select a new Event (which must be decided at the same time) and select new Equipment (at a later date).

11.5(d) The decision is on the recommendation of the Events Committee (concerning Events) and the Equipment Committee (concerning Equipment).

### Equipment Committee:

11.6(a) The GA decides the Equipment to be used for each Event.

11.6(e) Equipment must be selected following evaluation against approved criteria (which may include by equipment trials). The method of doing equipment trials is to be decided by the Equipment Committee with the approval of the Board.

11.6(f) World Sailing must consult any relevant World Sailing Class Associations and manufacturers of Equipment.

### Equipment Committee:

11.7(a) The Equipment Committee must re-evaluate all equipment to ensure that the market is fair and competitive.

11.7(b) Equipment must be re-evaluated at least every eight years.

11.7(c) The Equipment Committee decides the procedures to be used with the approval of the Board.

11.7(d) The Equipment Committee must recommend to retain or evolve the current Equipment or select new Equipment.

11.7(e) The Equipment Committee may make any other recommendation it considers necessary.

11.7(f) The recommendation goes to Council and the GA.



## Regulation 11 Timeline

### World Sailing Board:

11.9(a) Contracts for selected Equipment agreed between World Sailing, Class Associations and manufacturers.

11.9(c) In the event of unapproved contracts for particular Equipment, recommendations may be made to Council requesting the selection of alternative Equipment.



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## Regulation 11 Timeline

2029

Council decides  
format, qualification

### Events Committee:

11.8(a) Council must decide the format, qualification system, and quotas to be used on the recommendation of the Events Committee.



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## Regulation 11 Timeline

### **Priority Events Committee Actions:**

1. Recommend to Council at Annual Conference 2025 the format, qualification system, and quotas to be used for OSC in LA 2028 under 11.8(a).
2. Recommend to Council at Annual Conference 2025 to place at least four Events for OSC in Brisbane 2032 under review under 11.4.(a)
3. Recommend to Council at Annual Conference 2026 an Event Decision (retain Event and current Equipment; retain Event, evolve current Equipment; retain Event, select new Equipment; select new Event and Equipment) under 11.5(a)
4. Contribute to the work done by the Equipment Committee under 11.5 and 11.6



## Regulation 11 Timeline

### **Priority Equipment Committee Actions:**

1. Contribute to the work done by the Events Committee under 11.5.
2. Determine the criteria to be used, and whether that includes trials, to evaluate equipment under 11.6(e).
3. If equipment trials are to be done, determine those procedures with Board approval, also under 11.6(e).
4. Consult with relevant World Sailing Class Associations and manufacturers under 11.6(f).
5. Determine re-evaluation procedures to be used with Board approval under 11.7(c).
