

1. Overview of Class Agreements

- 1.1. Policy D2 notes that the Class Agreements shall include "The method of issuing and using World Sailing plaques, (...)".
- 1.2. As of 2024, World Sailing recognised 111 Class Associations, each operating under a distinct Class Agreement.
- 1.3. Class agreements generally follow one of three systems:
 - i. World Sailing distributes and sells plaques directly,
 - ii. The Class Association manages plaque distribution on behalf of World Sailing and reports sales,
 - iii. Alternative schemes, including equipment registration systems or fees based on a percentage of the retail price.
- 1.4. Details on how to order plaques and who is eligible to purchase plaques from World Sailing for each WS Class are publicly available on World Sailing's website under 'Technical Services':

- 1.5. This paper provides a breakdown of the number of plaques issued throughout 2024.

2. Plaques Overview for 2024

- 2.1. In 2024, of the 111 World Sailing-recognised classes:
 - i. 49 classes reported plaque sales
 - ii. 48 classes did not record any plaque sales
 - iii. 14 classes operated under an alternative scheme, where fees paid to World Sailing are not based on plaque issuance
 - iv. A total of 6,683 plaques were issued across all classes. The classes with the highest volume of plaques were:
 - o Optimist: 2,191 plaques
 - o ILCA 4,6 & 7: 1,881 plaques
- 2.2. The distribution of plaque sales shows that:
 - i. 6 classes accounted for 80% of all plaques issued
 - ii. 12 classes accounted for 90% of all plaques issued
- 2.3. The breakdown of plaques sold by class is included in the paper.
