1. Summary of Tests

This report is a summary of tests conducted in 2025 by Clearidium on behalf of World Sailing according to the Anti-Doping Service Agreement. The report was finalized on October 1st thus the numbers presented in the report are valid from January 1st - October 1st, 2025.

During this period Clearidium conducted 64 test attempts, including both completed tests and Unsuccessful Attempts (UA), on behalf of World Sailing. Collections were conducted both In-Competition (IC) and Out-of-Competition (OOC) across multiple countries and events.

Total Test Attempts: 64

In-Competition (IC): 4

Out-of-Competition (OOC): 52

Unsuccessful Attempts (UA): 8

2. In-Competition (IC) Breakdown by Event

IC testing was conducted in the Olympic disciplines IQFoil (M/W), ILCA 6 and ILCA 7 at:

- Semaine Olympique, Hyeres, France, April 25-26 : 4 tests
- World Kite Championships, Cagliari, Italy, October 5: 2 tests (scheduled Formula Kite (M/W))

In total, 4 athletes were tested IC, 2 females and 2 males.

Total IC tests expected in 2025: 6

3. Out-of-Competition (OOC) Overview

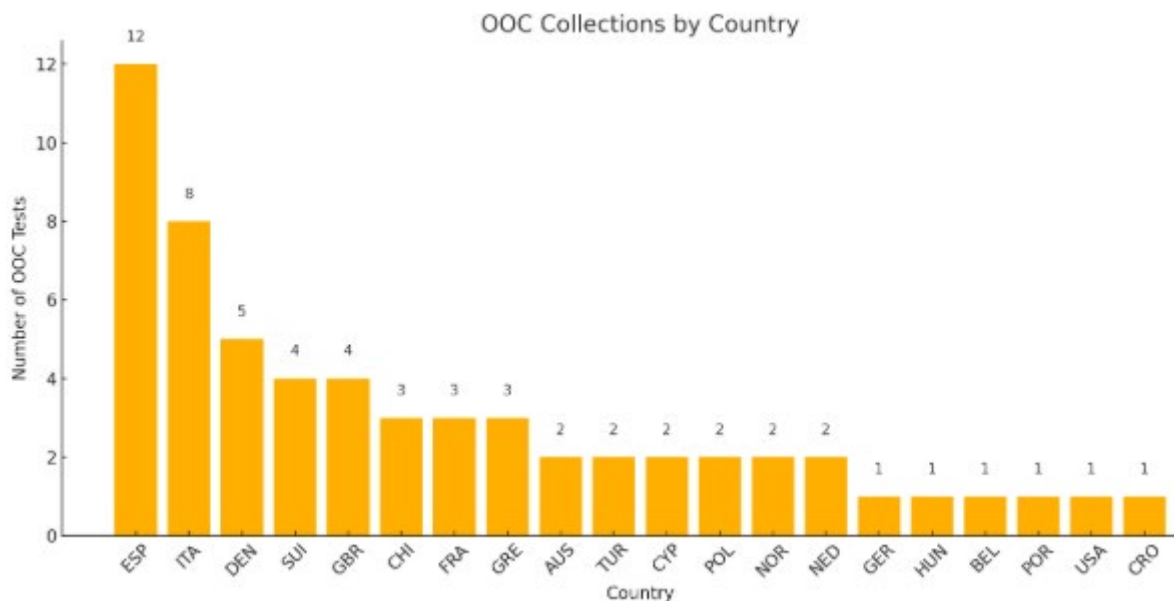
OOC testing was conducted based on Whereabouts information provided in ADAMS.

OOC testing was conducted according to World Sailing Registered Testing Pool and Testing Pool 2025 in the

Olympic disciplines 470 crew (W), 470 helm (M), 49er crew, 49erFX crew, 49erFX helm, Formula Kite (M/W), ILCA 6, ILCA 7, iQFoil (M/W), NACRA 17 crew (M/W) and NACRA 17 helm (M), and Parasailing (M).

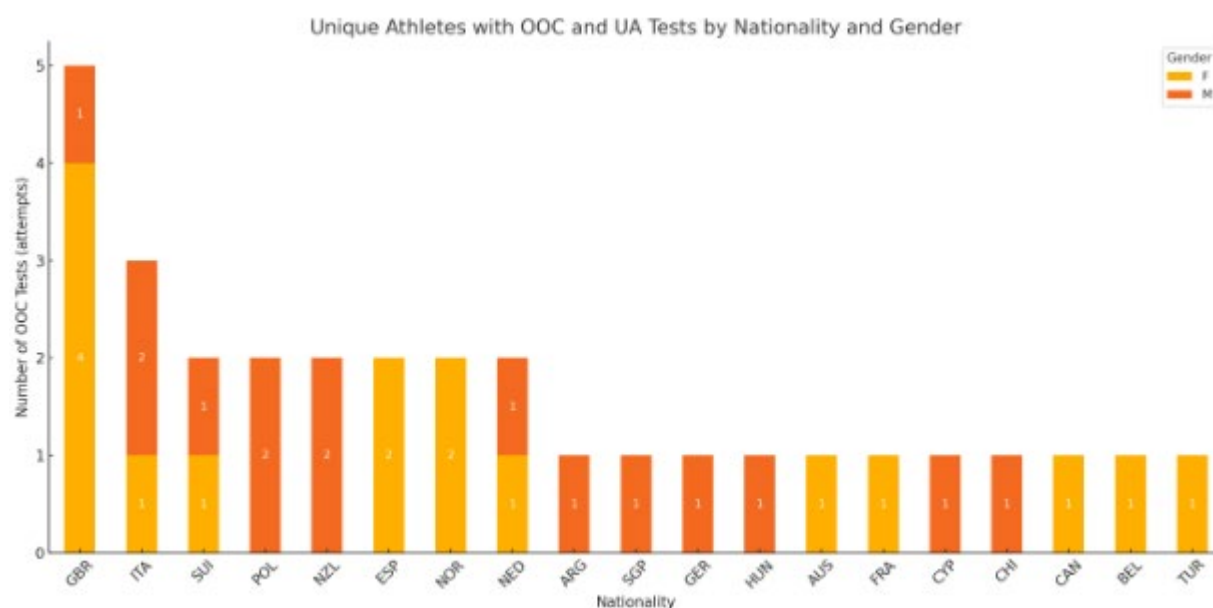
OOO collections by country:

In total, OOC collections (attempts) were completed in 20 countries.



OOO collections by nationality and gender:

In total, 31 athletes were attempted one or more times. Of the 31 athletes, 16 were females and 15 males.

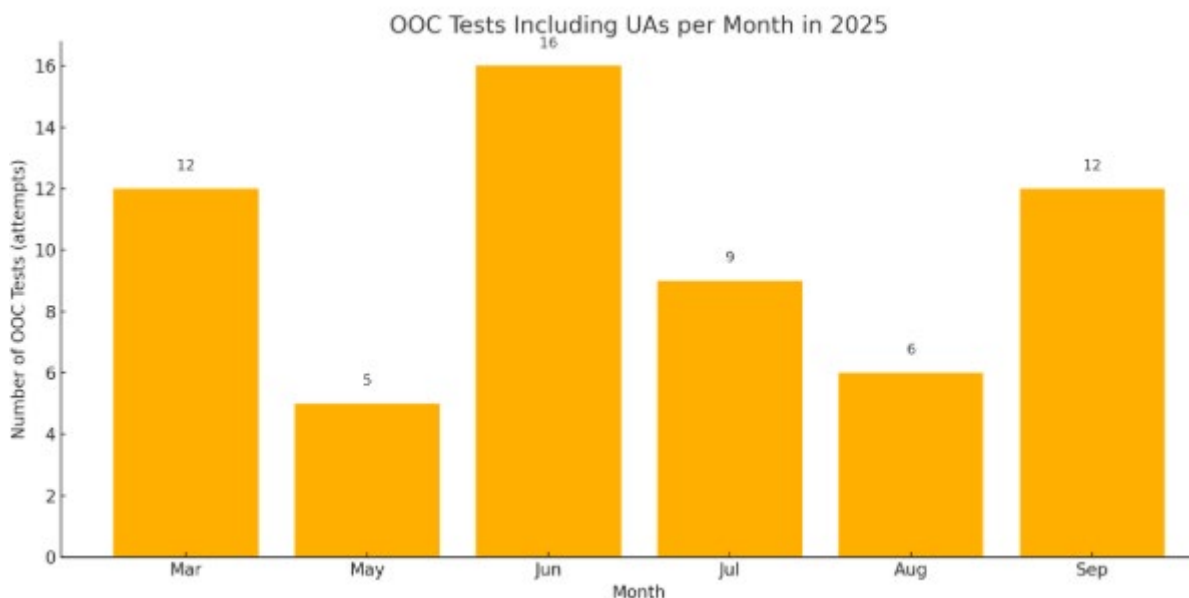

2. Certification & Quality Assurance

- Secure sample transport to WADA-accredited laboratories using tamper-evident equipment and documented handovers.

As a Sample Collection Agency (SCA) operating under WADA's framework, Clearidium A/S operates as an independent and neutral party contracted by International Federations, National Anti-Doping Organizations (NADOs), and Major Event Organizers.

Our core operational principles include:

- Strict independence: Clearidium conducts testing activities without any influence from sport governing bodies, ensuring impartial and unbiased sample collection.
- Qualified personnel: All Doping Control Officers (DCOs) are trained and certified in accordance with the WADA International Standard for Testing and Investigations (ISTI), including both blood and urine collection procedures and athlete interaction protocols.
- Quality and Compliance Assurance: Clearidium undergoes annual audits by one of the world's leading certification bodies, verifying compliance with ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System standards.
- Global reach: Through an extensive international network of trained DCOs, Clearidium delivers in-competition and out-of-competition testing worldwide - often at short notice.
- Confidentiality and Data Protection: All athlete data are handled in full compliance with WADA's International Standards for the Protection of Privacy and Personal Information (ISPPPI) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Through these measures, Clearidium A/S not only ensures compliance but actively contributes to the global effort to maintain fair play and athlete health in sport.
