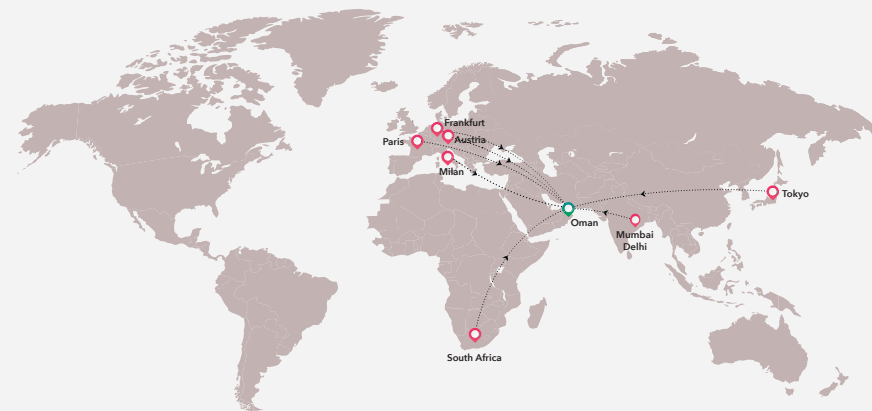

Venue Layout

Oman Sail manages the marina with 54 berths, dockside support, boat cleaning, and fuel services. The resort hosts a sailing school and the National Teams, offering world-class, eco-friendly facilities.

Coach Boat Charter

Coach boats are available with limited numbers to charter on a first-come, first-served basis, at a fee of 120 OMR (on a shared basis per day).

Kindly direct your request to the event operations manager, Feras Asqul (feras@omansail.com, Mobile: +968 9410 7151).

There will also be a damage deposit of 500 EUR/220 OMR.

The allocations and distributions of the coach boats will be shared separately.

Note: the fee includes the VAT, excluding fuel and captain

VHF Radios/UHF Radios

VHF radios are not allowed into Sultanate of Oman for sailing regattas because of strict national telecom and import regulations.

The Omani Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (TRA) requires all radio equipment to be licensed and frequency-approved before use. Bringing unregistered VHF sets could interfere with official maritime or coastguard communications.

Customs regulations also make importing unapproved radio gear complicated or prohibited.

Oman Sail will agree with World Sailing on required allocation and distribution.

There will be a damage deposit of 150 EUR/70 OMR.

- Visit the **Daymaniyat Islands Nature Reserve** famous for green and hawksbill turtles, rays, moray eels, vibrant coral reefs and pristine waters.
- Spot the **resident green turtles** in the Barceló Mussanah marina.



These animals are protected, so please admire them respectfully and never touch or disturb turtles or coral.

A visit to the Daymaniyat Islands may be available during the tourism day or for those extending their stay for those who wish to explore responsibly.



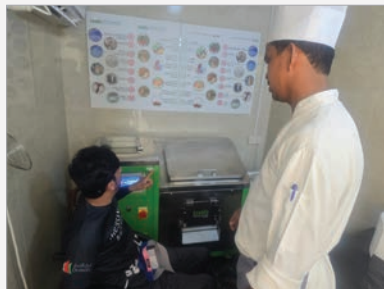

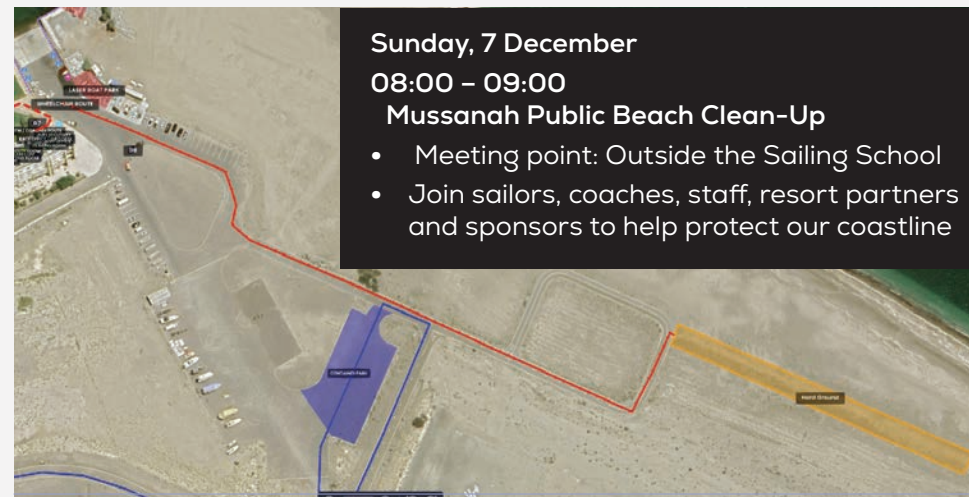

- for health and safety reasons, two staff members must be present per floating wheelchair.
- we kindly request 24 hours' notice if you are interested in using the wheelchairs to coordinate staffing within the event delivery.

Meet your guide in the hotel lobby and begin a full-day discovery of the Batinah region, starting with the magnificent Al Hazm Castle, a masterpiece of Omani architecture featuring carved doors, winding

passages, and panoramic watchtowers, with inclusive audio headsets available for blind visitors. Continue to Rustaq to explore the historic Rustaq Market, one of Oman's oldest trading hubs where mountain and coastal communities once gathered to exchange goods ranging from fruits and fish to traditional crafts. Proceed to the UNESCO-listed Falaj Al-Maysar, an impressive example of ancient Omani water engineering set amidst historical and archaeological landmarks.
