Notice to Competitors

Tracking

According to Sailing Instruction Addendum D, Boats will be required to carry tracking.

This notice serves as instructions for their use.

Rules and procedures for the use and installation of the tracking equipment on board:

Each day of racing, starting on the 4th December, devices will be available from 0930 at the Tracking office, located in the Race Office (Dive Centre in the Oman Sail building).

Each sailor or Team must personally pick -up the correspondent device (1 per sailor or team) at the tracking desk.

Devices will be delivered already on standby mode. Sailors DO NOT need to do anything to activate or deactivate the device.

Each device has only one button which has no functionality.

The TracTrac operator can manage the configuration of the system remotely. Sailors must not try to push the button placed on the device.

Each sailor will keep the device until the end of the racing day. Devices will need to be returned to the organization each day at the tracking office for charging. The participant will be the responsible of the device return.

Where and how to fix the device:

Device must be fixed on the sailor/ crew, using the clip and rope provided on the pouch. It can then be tucked into a pocket and worn under your event bib as required.
