Notice to Competitors

Information on Packing Up Boats

Dear Sailors and Coaches,

Upon completion of racing Today ALL competitors are **required** to help and assist with de-rigging their boat.

This means for the RSVC, 3 Teams per boat.

For the Hansa 303, 3 Sailors per boat.

For the ILCA, 1 sailor per boat.

For the Fareast, 1 Team per boat, and 2 Teams supporting.

Deposits will not be returned unless the boats are signed back in by all teams/ sailors together and approved by the Dock and Slipway Teams from Oman Sail.

Below is a table for each fleet with what needs to be de-rigged completely.

It is very simple instructions but if you require further assistance or have any questions, please let the Oman Sail and World Sailing Teams know.

Drop the Mast (tidy, tape etc, then lash to the deck for safety)
Remove boom and kicker
Keel up (using the keel lifts)
Rudders up
All sails rolled and placed in the boat
Leave boat in original parking spacing ensuring they are not touching each other etc, and there is adequate space and they are CORRECTLY parked!



Hansa 303

Take masts down and secured to deck
Sails rolled around masts
Boom off
Keel up and pin in
Rudder blades removed
Leave boat in original parking space, ensure they are not touching each other etc, and there is adequate space, and they are CORRECTLY parked!



Wash boats with hose
Take mast down and remove sail
Take battens out of sail and fold sail away
Remove rudder, tiller and daggerboard and place in bag provided
Remove all ropes (mainsheet, outhaul, kicker etc.) and place in bag provided
Place clewstraps securely on hiking straps
Place cover on boat and park up

Mains and Jibs removed and stored away in boat

Please return rib and radio to the coach boat area, clean, tidy and with all equipment on board.

Take your key/ kill-cord to the Oman Sail representative.

Once approved, return to the registration desk so you can be charged for your fuel etc and have your damage deposit returned.
